Green River: A Legacy Revived. Started in 1885, Owensboro-based Green River is the 10<sup>th</sup> oldest distillery licensed in Kentucky.

Green River Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey is 90 proof and aged onsite at some of the oldest warehouses in the state. Rich in color with a golden-amber hue, Green River is made with locally sourced corn featuring a mashbill of 70% corn, 21% winter rye and 9% malted barley. The higher rye content contributes warming spice notes on the nose and palate.



**Mash Bill:**

70% Kentucky Grown Corn  
21% Rye  
9% Malted Barley

**Appearance:**

Rich, golden-amber color

**Tasting Notes:**

Full of warming spice, vanilla, caramel and chocolate-coated peppermints with aromatic notes of cinnamon, dried cherry and light leather.

**Finish:**

Lingering, rich mouthfeel
