Founded in 1885, Owensboro-based Green River is the 10th oldest distillery licensed in Kentucky.

Resurrected in 2014, Green River is distilled and bottled on the same hallowed grounds as it was well over a century ago, all in a beautiful reimagined package that evokes the aesthetic, heritage, and storied history of this authentic and fascinating brand. It's why we call Green River "a legacy revived."









1885Green river founded

J.W. McCulloch founded the distillery in 1885, making it the 10th oldest licensed in Kentucky (DSP-KY-10).



1907 Creating a legacy

Green River became the most advertised whiskey in the world.



1917 Striking Literal Gold!

The whiskey was so popular that 20 barrels were once traded for interest in a Colorado gold mine that panned out, earning Green River the title "most expensive spirit or whiskey ever sold."



1933 Post-Prohibition

The distillery was rebuilt and the brand sold off to another company. After Prohibition, no medical claims could be made with alcohol so the slogan was changed to "The Whiskey Without Regrets."



2014LIKE THE PHOENIX

The distillery began reconstruction, preserving as much of the original facility as possible.


2024THE PRIDE OF OWENSPORD

Green River returned to the shelves again and expanded its distribution across the country with an original bourbon whiskey, wheated bourbon, rye, and single barrel expression.

THE WHISKEY WITHOUT A HEADACHE

Widely advertised as "The Whiskey Without A Headache" for its premium quality, it was once the official whiskey of the U.S. Marine Hospital.



1918 On fire

At the height of its reign, a mysterious fire reduced the distillery empire to ashes and destroyed more than 40,000 barrels of whiskey within three hours.

GREEN RIVER DRIES UP

Green River eventually stopped distribution. The distillery changed hands several times and was eventually abandoned.



2016The Stills run again

Once again, Green River Whiskey was distilled and aged where it originally started 131 years prior.













THE WHISKEY WITHOUT REGRETS

Green River lore is some of the most fascinating in the whiskey world.

As the official whiskey of the U.S. Marine Hospital for 18 years in the early 20th century, Green River was known as "the whiskey without a headache," a tagline featured prominently on the bottle, throughout the brand's merchandising, and in Green River's many national ads. After Prohibition, this tagline later changed to "the Whiskey Without Regrets," when whiskey was no longer considered medicinal.

Songs were penned about the "Whiskey Without Regrets," and early reviews described it as a "king among whiskeys." The whiskey won many international awards, including a gold medal and "best of show" at the Paris Exposition in 1900, and later a grand prize at the 1905 Liege Exposition in Belgium. The Whiskey Without Regrets tagline is a gateway to telling Green River's rich story and a consistent nod to the brand's heritage forging into the future.

Rye features a classic mashbill of: 95% rye 5% malted barley
